## **THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE HELLOSKY LOUNGE AT MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT**

The HelloSky Lounge is celebrating its first anniversary since it opened in the departures area at Milan Bergamo Airport. Dedicated to international and domestic traffic and situated just before the new passport control area at the entrance to the non-Schengen area, its management has been entrusted by SACBO to GIS, a leading company in airport hospitality services based in Barcelona, Spain, and a branch of TAV Operation Services (TAV OS).

The first anniversary was celebrated with a special cake in the presence of Albert Vilumara Perez, the CEO of CIS, Emilio Bellingardi, the managing director of SACBO, and Matteo Bau, the non-aviation commercial director for SACBO.

Over the course of its first year of activity, the HelloSky Milan Bergamo Lounge, one of the most elegant, extensively equipped and fitted on the national and international scene, has been warmly received by its guests, to the extent of receiving the highest possible score in the survey of appreciation by airport users periodically carried out by the Airports Council International (ACI) World.

Inspired by a new concept in VIP lounges, which focuses on the environment, sustainability and recycling, the HelloSky Milan Bergamo lounge has been designed with the use of natural light and materials, offering a high level of quality and comfort and a relaxing atmosphere for passengers who choose to spend time there.

The lounge, which covers an area of 750 m<sup>2</sup> and has 130 seats, is divided into 10 different areas, including working zones, meeting rooms, an F&B area, a smoking area and toilets and showers. The services offered include a bar, refreshments and *à la carte* restaurants, as well as entertainment and rest areas, with personnel on hand to welcome and assist guests.

A prestigious calling card that serves to render time in the airport before departure as comfortable as possible, the HelloSky Milan Bergamo Lounge is preparing to welcome a growing number of passengers, also in light of the appointment with Bergamo and Brescia's term as joint Capitals of Culture 2023.

To celebrate the first anniversary of the HelloSky Milan Bergamo Lounge, SACBO is providing passengers with two new products; the first combines access to the HelloSky Lounge with Fast Track access, while the second offers a stay in the HelloSky Lounge and Fast Track Plus, which provides the possibility to check-in and register luggage in the Check-in Lounge, where dedicated access is granted to security controls.
