



Milan Bergamo Airport and Air Arabia announce a new direct connection with Sharjah International Airport (UAE)

Air Arabia, the leading low-cost airline (LCC) in the Middle East and North Africa, announced today that they have launched the first direct flight between Milan Bergamo airport and the United Arab Emirates.

Starting from 7th December 2022, the new Air Arabia flight will connect Milan Bergamo Airport four times weekly with Sharjah International Airport, which is located a few kilometres from the city centre and just twenty minutes from Dubai.
